She has worked professionally as an engineer in the film industry for over twenty years at both Skywalker Sound and Pixar Animation Studios. Among many mainstream film credits, she has also worked as a recording engineer on *Wild at Heart* (1990, Drama, 124min), and assistant sound editor on *It's Elementary* (1996, Documentary, 80min), and *Mary Jane's Not a Virgin Anymore* (1997, Drama, 98min).

**Jennifer Chinlund (Editor)** has edited many films in her 25-year career.
